Scope of the study program

The program is focused on mediation of necessary knowledge for deep understanding of various environmental risks and on the possibilities of country components (soil, water, atmosphere) remediation. The graduate study comprises two parts: a study part and a research part. A plan of the study is prepared by the supervisor, and should be approved by a committee.

Profile of a graduate

The graduate can find application in state, business or non-governmental sector as a specialist for environmental problems in management, specialist and scientific teams, which solve problems of the environmental burdens remediation. A graduate will have skills both for solution of a complex scientific and practice problems

Requirements on applicants

The applicant is required to have completed the Master-degree in relative study field with a good basis from natural science branches. Masters in other subjects are considered on case-by-case basis. All applicants have to pass an entrance exam. The exam committee is appointed by the Dean of the Faculty of Natural Sciences. Supervisor of a prospective graduate student is a member of the exam committee.
